Looking for electives to take in the Fall?

Check out these two courses, each provides both real-world & academic experiences. Neither class has pre-requisites.

Management of Information Systems (CRN 41298) is a case-based, strategic look at the challenges and techniques for managing IS in small and large organizations. Mgmt 630 is relevant for all MBA concentrations, because individuals from all functional areas participate in successful IT strategy and implementation teams. Prof. Laurie Schatzberg is offering Mgmt630.001 online for the second time in Fall 2011. A highlight of the course has been the small team partnerships with CIOs in the region.

Project Management (CRN 33860) is a hands-on course in project management. In addition to academic readings, students learn from a web-based project management simulation and have the opportunity to partner with Project Management Professionals in the region. Ever been involved in projects where you've worked with skilled and weak project managers? Whatever your concentration, it is likely that you'll be involved in projects throughout your career, and you may be asked to lead some. Consider this course if you'd like to become an effective project leader.
