ANDERSON BIG SHOTS

The Anderson School celebrated donors and the students who benefit from their generosity at the ninth annual Celebration of Giving Scholarship Reception last Friday at the Embassy Suites Hotel. MACCT Taxation Candidate Megan O’Laughlin graciously introduced the speakers for the event and handed out gift bags. This year there were a total of 316 applications for scholarships and fellowships and 136 awards were made for award coverage of 43%. Chair of the Scholarship Committee, Ann Brooks, says fifty-four percent of the applications were from self-identified minorities. Total funds awarded for the 2011-2012 academic year was just over \$253,000 and the average award was approximately \$4,690.
